The construction of Chita primary school was started on the 18<sup>th</sup> of June, 2010. Funded by the Exilda's Angels Charity organization, based in the united kingdom. The

community has been part and parcel of this school project and they continue to be so today.

Many other individuals have contributed their precious energy and time towards the construction of this school. In particular, I would like to mention the following people; Fr. Chomba was the first financial controller of the project, which he performed with his utmost integrity.

Teaching and learning began on the 8<sup>th</sup> of October, 2012, with a total enrolment of 174 pupils from grades 1 to 4. These were directly off loaded from Chibansa primary school.

To date the school has 137 boys and 136 girls and 8 trained teachers employed by the Zambian government. The school is currently running from grades one to six.

The Guest of Honour, Sir,

The establishment of this school in this locality, has cheered and brought up immeasurable joy and happiness to all the parents and children from the surrounding villages, in that our children can now walk affordable distances to this school to access the much treasured quality education.

The parents and children of Chita community have seen this school being built and develop to its current status, this has instilled a strong sense of ownership and

patriotism. And hence, the school is being looked after jealously, and no act of Vandalism shall be tolerated.

Currently, each of the seven villages has been assigned to mould an average of 5,000 bricks and to dig one pit latrine each. In addition, the community is about to complete constructing a temporary classroom shelter, intended to mitigate the current in adequate teaching and learning space.

From what I have outlined above, we the teachers of Chita primary school, the parents and the children, we have every reason to celebrate this wonderful event and we cheerfully thank Allan Shand and the entire Exilda's Angels charity for every thing they have done to make this event a success.
